

Attendee Information for On The Beach

To ensure the safety of our staff & audience we encourage all customers to follow the public health guides when attending On The Beach.

These guidelines include:

- Taking a covid-19 lateral flow test within 48hrs of the event and registering your result via the GOV UK website (link below).
- Wearing masks whenever in enclosed or crowded spaces.
- Checking in via the NHS Track & Trace app when arriving on-site.

- If you are feeling unwell or have any symptoms of Covid-19 please do not attend the event.
- We would also like to remind customers that the event is 18+ and proof of age by Passport or Driving Licence may be required to gain entry.

Age Verification

This is an 18 and over event – no exceptions. All persons who appear to be under 25 will be asked to produce identification. Acceptable ID is limited to valid passport or driving licence only.

How do I get to the venue?

ADDRESS: Brighton Beach, Madeira Drive

Wherever possible, please arrive via on foot or public transport.

- **On foot:** If facing the Pier, walk left along Madeira Drive (towards Concorde2) until you see the entrance signs
- **By train:** The nearest station is Brighton – 15 minutes walking distance.
- **By bus:** Old Steine / Marine Parade / Marina are all short walks from the venue.
- **By car:** Parking in Brighton is a rare find. If you have hours to spare to look for one, please at least car share. Please do not drop off passengers outside the venue.
- **By taxi:** Please do not take a taxi directly to the venue – drop offs are strongly discouraged.

What time do gates open?

Please note that the time may be subject to slight change, so please ensure you check the website www.onthebeach-events.com or our Facebook/Instagram for the confirmed timings:

Friday: 1700 (last entry 2030)

Saturday: 1400 (last entry 1800)

Sunday: 1400 (last entry 1800)

What should I bring?

- ID
- Sunscreen / Hat (no covered areas available)
- Cash Cards
- Appropriate Footwear & Clothing (venue is a pebbled beach)

Do the bars accept cash?

We are operating a cashless system. All bars and food concessions will be card only.

What are the security restrictions in place at this concert?

Please note the below is not an exhaustive list.

- No bags are permitted that are larger than A4 in size – no exceptions. There are no lockers available.
- Everyone attending the event is subject to bag and person search and some people may be asked to take part in enhanced searches. In the unlikely event you refuse to take part in a search, you will not be admitted.
- Illegal weapons & drugs are not permitted by law and will be confiscated. Anyone in possession of such items may be reported to the police.
- Dogs are not allowed on site unless they are seeing eye, assistant dogs
- Prescribed medication should be declared before entering the search and entry points. Medicine should be in its original packaging and the ticket holder must bring a copy of their prescription in their own name.
- E-cigarette liquid is only allowed if it is sealed and easily identifiable. If it can't be identified or the seal is broken, it will be confiscated.

The following items are prohibited:

- Glass
- Nitrous Oxide / Noz / Balloons
- Illegal drugs

- Spray Cans
- Fireworks / flares
- Barbecues or camping stoves
- Sound systems
- Food / Drink
- Barbeques (including disposable)
- Signs or materials displaying discriminatory, derogatory or offensive messages, slogans or images
- Any item that could be considered an offensive weapon
- Unauthorised Professional Recording, Film or Video Equipment
- Drones

Re Entry

If you leave the event you will not be permitted to re enter.

Can I bring food & drink into the venue?

No external food or drink is permitted to be brought into the venue. If you have a specific dietary requirement which cannot be satisfied by the on-site caterers, permission to bring alternative provisions requires written confirmation from enquiries@onthebeach-events.com. You can bring a small bottle of un-opened water into the venue - if it has been opened it will be confiscated. Water is available free of charge from the bar.

What is the accessibility like at the venue?

The venue is fully accessible, however the event is on a pebbled beach. This is also an open air venue. There is an area for accessible viewing

Weather and ground conditions may be variable and mobility around the site may become more difficult.
